Meeting Agenda

Business

A court order rescinding the October 5 authorization to reimburse for the cold weather shelter and now authorizing a donation to be made to Community Mission to build a cold weather shelter facility and will pay invoices to the entities providing the supplies and labor was presented and approved by Commissioner Hook, Commissioner Burnham and Presiding Commissioner Sawyer.

A court order authorizing a check to Cereal Ingredients for Economic Development was presented and approved by Commissioner Hook, Commissioner Burnham and Presiding Commissioner Sawyer.

A court order acknowledging receipt of official results of the November 8, 2022 General Election was presented and approved by Commissioner Hook, Commissioner Burnham and Presiding Commissioner Sawyer.

Dr. Adam Wineinger joined the meeting at 9:30. He shared some statistics this year to date on overdoses and autopsies. The new process that is in place is working, however still has some issues to work out. Commissioner's and Dr. Wineinger discussed options on medical investigators process, time and pay.
