Meeting Minutes Monday, August 5, 2024

A court order authorizing funds to Drug Strike Force was presented and approved by Commissioner Burnham, Presiding Commissioner Nelson, and Commissioner Hook.

Commissioner Burnham stated he spoke to Darren Farnan with United Fiber discussing the last 2 projects the County would like to have completed with broadband. He told Darren the dollar amount the county has to fund this. Darren is checking to see what percentages they can offer to contribute to this project.

Commissioner Hook advised Commissioner Burnham and Presiding Commissioner Nelson he and County Counselor Josh Bachman will be meeting with Don Evans to discuss the tower lease and easement.

Commissioners talked about the levee, the levee board. Commissioner Burnham said he has been asked by constituents about a feasibility study on dredging lake contrary, he also stated that he thinks this project should be put to a vote by the voters of Buchanan County.
