**CONSTITUTIONAL  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Proposed by the 85th  
General Assembly

(First Regular Session)

Changes membership requirements for persons participating in bingo operations, and removes advertising restrictions. This proposal would have minimal impact on state funds.

**CONSTITUTIONAL  
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

Proposed by the 85th  
General Assembly

(Second Regular Session)

Authorizes legislature to enact legislation to establish neighborhood improvement districts whereby residents of the district may, by vote, incur indebtedness to pay for public improvements therein. Vote requirements are specified, and allowable indebtedness is limited. Enabling legislation and voter approval would be required before this amendment could have any fiscal impact.

**CONSTITUTIONAL  
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

Proposed by the 85th  
General Assembly

(Second Regular Session)

Requires four-sevenths majority of those voting to approve certain operating levies in counties, cities and school districts on municipal, primary and general election dates only. Retains two-thirds majority on other election dates. The effect of this amendment on any tax rate would depend upon actions of the voters in the various political sub-divisions.

**CONSTITUTIONAL  
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

Proposed by the 85th  
General Assembly

(Second Regular Session)

Would create a state department of insurance, with office of consumer affairs therein. Other duties and responsibilities to be prescribed by law. Changes the Missouri division of insurance to a department, with costs to be determined by the enabling legislation for this amendment.
